TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. CONFIRMATION** – Sea Life Surveys (therein SLS) will not consider the holiday to be booked until the completed booking form and a deposit of 50% of the price have been received by them. Any person who makes a booking for or on behalf of any other passenger or group of passengers warrants and confirms that he has the authority of each such passenger to accept these conditions as passenger agrees to be bound by these conditions. All cheques should be made payable to SEA LIFE SURVEYS LTD.
- 2. CHANGES** - SLS reserves the right to alter the advertised programme of cruises or holidays in any way which they consider necessary or desirable due to adverse weather or any other conditions. Also if SLS experiences any major changes in cost between the time of booking and the time of departure they reserve the right to change the prices in accordance with any such change in cost.
- 3. SEA LIFE SURVEYS** - gives notice that all arrangements which they make are made on the express condition that they will not be liable for any loss, damage, delay, irregularity, injury or death whatsoever which may arise or be caused either by reason of any defect in vessels or vehicles, through default of any company or persons engaged in conveying passengers or in carrying out the arrangements of the holiday(s) or otherwise in connection therewith: or of any servant or employee or for any failure on the part of SLS or agent to provide any of the facilities normally available or for any other reason. In addition SLS does not accept any responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delays in changes in air, rail, road, sea or other services, strikes, war, weather or any other cause.
- 4. CANCELLATION** - If, owing to circumstances beyond its control, SWS is unable to provide the vessel or holiday booked or a suitable alternative SWS will refund any monies paid to it in full and the passenger shall have no further claim against SWS in respect of this.
- 5. REMAINDER OF FEE** - The passenger, or in the case of a whole boat booking, the person chartering the vessel is personally responsible for the whole of the fee and the balance must be paid **SIX WEEKS** prior to the start of the holiday. If the passenger or charterer for any reason requires to cancel his/her booking he/she remains responsible for the whole of the fee. SLS will attempt to resell the accommodation, as long as it is out with the six weeks, and if successful in this will refund the deposit and any other money paid less any additional costs or insurance.
- 6. MASTER** - All decisions regarding the safety of the vessel, its tender and all those on board rest ultimately with the Skipper. The Skipper or SLS may (notwithstanding any booking previously made) refuse to carry any passenger or any luggage on any cruise for any reason relating to the safety of the vessel or the passengers or of any of the other property on board the vessel. If such circumstances should arise, the passenger shall not be entitled to, nor shall he/she receive, any compensation or payment whatsoever except that if a passenger is refused carriage on any cruise SLS shall refund to that passenger any fare paid to SLS in respect of that cruise.
- 7. INSURANCE COVER** - The vessel carries full marine insurance for physical injury or accident to any passenger while on board the vessel. SLS is covered up to £3,000,000 in respect of any one accident.
- 8. PRIVATE PROPERTY** – Whilst the vessels ran by SLS are covered by full Marine Insurance for bodily injury or accident to any passengers, SLS does not accept responsibility for loss of or damage to passengers' personal effects, property or valuables whilst on board the vessel or in transit. We would therefore recommend you check your own insurance cover or take out a separate policy to cover the duration of your holiday.
- 9. SUPPLY OF EQUIPMENT** - If any of the SLS equipment which is used aboard by passengers is lost or damaged the charterer shall be liable for the repair or replacement thereof.



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TERMS & CONDITIONS (continued)

10. MISUSE OF DRUGS - Drugs or other unlawful goods or substances are prohibited on board the vessel at all times and SWS shall not be liable or responsible for any breach of this condition by any of the passengers.

11. ABILITY OF PASSENGERS - For all trips and packages access to the main vessel will be by tender. Passengers will need to climb on and off the vessel, and pier, whilst the vessel's tender is alongside, they do so at their own risk. Sturdy footwear is important as we will be landing passengers in remote locations with rough terrain

12. UNDER AGE - No unaccompanied children under the age of 16 can be carried. Children under the age of 16 will be the responsibility of their parents/guardians at all times.

13. LEGAL ACTION - Any legal action or proceedings arising out of or connected with this contract shall be governed by the Laws of Scotland.

14. SINGLE OCCUPANCY - of a room incurs a 20% surcharge. If a partner for a twin share is not found 6 weeks prior to departure the single supplement will apply.

15. HALF BOARD - All package holiday prices include bed and breakfast per person, packed lunch, and transport on the island, passenger ferry tickets, and boat trips. We DO NOT include evening meals, but we are able to assist in transport to restaurants if needed, this must be pre-arranged.

16. SEA WILD SCOTLAND – Is our package holiday name, and is part of the Sea Life Surveys Ltd Group.

IS THIS HOLIDAY SUITABLE FOR CHILDREN? – Our shorter holiday, the Weekend Explorer is suitable for children. Our longer holidays are more suitable for older children; please contact us if you are unsure.

DO YOU HAVE ANY FITNESS REQUIREMENTS? – None of our holidays are hard going, but we do require a small level of fitness so that you are capable of getting in and out of tenders, and walking across rough terrain on most islands we visit. Sturdy footwear is recommended for all holidays.

WHAT IS THE ACCOMMODATION LIKE? - We use both bed & breakfast and hotels of a high standard, with a minimum of 3 stars. Perhaps you would like something closer to where we are based, like the Bellachroy Hotel in the quiet village of Dervaig, or nearby Druimnacraish Hotel that has a restaurant with a sumptuous menu. Across the loch there is the new 4 star Drovers Lodge and a few miles away, above the yellow sands, there is the idyllic Calgary Hotel. Please choose your accommodation, and we will do the rest. (All accommodation is subject to availability. There is a single supplement charge of 20%)

WHAT ABOUT THE SCOTTISH WEATHER?! - Although the weather can be unpredictable, the west coast of Scotland is littered with over forty different islands, with hundreds of safe bays to anchor in, there is always somewhere safe.
